

**The 16 to 19 tuition fund 2021 to 2022 academic year**  
**Statement of intent for use of funds: Ark John Keats Academy**

Ark John Keats operates in an area of high social deprivation. 38% of our pupils are entitled to free school meals, and 51% of our pupils are EAL. As a result, COVID has had a significant impact on the progress our KS5 pupils have made. We intend to allocate our tuition fund based on how far students have fallen behind, and their individual level of need.

We intend to use this tuition fund for targeted support with the following cohorts.

**1: Pupils who have not achieved a 4 in Maths**

We have a small number of year 12 pupils who did not achieve a 4 in Maths. They will be our first priority when allocating this fund. We will use the fund to support teaching of small-group or one-to-one sessions with these students, focussing on skill development and exam technique to best prepare for GCSE resits

**2: Pupils significantly below MEG in year 13**

We have selected a group of pupils who are under both below MEG and at risk of attaining a U, E or D. These are all students who have disproportionately been impacted by COVID restrictions. We will use this fund to provide external tuition for these pupils. These sessions will be delivered by a third party provider and monitored by the school. They will be subject specific and focussed on areas of weakness from year 12 SOWs, as identified at assessment points. While these pupils have under attained in a range of subjects, they are primarily clustered in Economics, psychology, sociology and the Sciences. These subjects will therefore be prioritised when allocating funding.
