



School Uniform

Most of the scholars who attend our academy wear their uniforms to school every day with pride.

How do they show this pride?

- ✓ They always have the correct uniform (including a tie!)
- ✓ They always have their shirt top button done up
- ✓ They wear smart black school shoes and navy or black socks/tights
- ✓ No boots allowed in school
- ✓ They only wear shoes with laces if they can tie these by themselves
- ✓ Longer hair is always tied back—hair accessories are our academy colours (**navy blue; fuchsia pink or black**) and is not too big or elaborate
- ✓ They have the correct P.E kit at school—a navy school tracksuit (with the embroidered golden quill) for the winter and a white school polo shirt (also with the embroidered golden quill) and navy blue shorts for the summer. They also have black plimsolls or trainers for these lessons—no school shoes allowed during P.E lessons.

Please do make sure that your child wears the correct uniform to school every day. If they do not wear it, it is unfair on them because we discuss it with them in school a lot and pupils who are wearing the incorrect uniform are spoken to by all staff.

You can help your child to avoid those discussions with staff by sending them into school wearing the correct uniform every day.

Please make sure that your child's uniform is clearly marked with a permanent marker/name label to avoid these items getting lost.

- ✓ Sleeveless/long sleeve jumper and/or blazer (jumpers with embroidered logo)
- ✓ Navy blue hat for hot weather (no logos or elaborate colours/patterns)
- ✓ No summer dresses allowed
- ✓ P.E kit—white polo shirt with embroidered logo; blue shorts; plimsolls or trainers
