COVID-19 Coronavirus Update

We want to state there are no known reported cases of anyone in our school or Enfield that has tested positive for the COVID-19 Coronavirus. We want to reiterate that it is 'business as usual' with regards to pupils attending school.

However, we have put the below measures in place to support England Health in containing the spread of the virus:

- We have ceased the shaking of hands in the mornings, before pupils enter their classes as well as at home time (you received a letter regarding this on Monday).
- We have spoken to all the scholars about the importance of washing their hands when they come into school first thing in the morning; before they go to eat their lunch; when they enter the school building after playtime; and every time after they go to the toilet.
- We have put up posters encouraging and reminding all scholars to wash their hands.
- We are temporarily reducing the number of parents that can attend our celebration assemblies (only parents of pupils receiving a certificate for scholar of the class will be allowed to attend).
- We have made the decision to postpone all educational visits where pupils are required to travel by public transport (see below for more details). Local trips to the library and swimming pool will continue as usual.



AJK's Times Tables Rockstars
