**In Science, Year 6 have been learning about circuits. We have been identifying the different components of a circuit, as well as investigating how circuits work. Arya has neatly written up her hypothesis and carefully carried out her experiment to prove whether her theory was correct or not.**

**In Writing, Year 6 have been focusing on the key elements that make a good newspaper article. James has written some excellent, detailed answers as a newspaper reporter, which have featured year six grammatical devices such as using the passive voice, relative clauses and direct speech.**

**In Maths, scholars have been learning about measurement and Rojan's neatly presented work shows how we compare and convert different measurements. Along with the whole of Year 6 they have all been working very hard to improve their mathematical vocabulary and their presentation in Maths.**

**This term Year 6 scholars are creating war artwork in the style of Paul Nash (He was a surrealist painter and war artist). Ayshe has read the description very carefully and used key vocabulary from the description when creating her artwork in the style of Paul Nash.**

In addition to their fantastic written work in books this week, Year 6 have also impressed us with their maturity during discussions in Jigsaw. We've been learning about some very grown up topics such as substances and gangs and both classes have approached the content so sensibly and contributed to both partner and class conversations.
