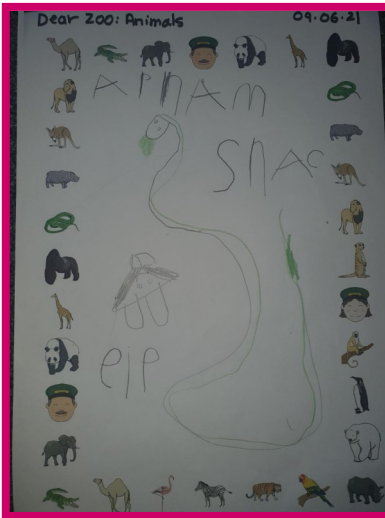
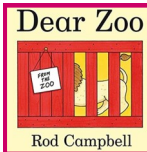




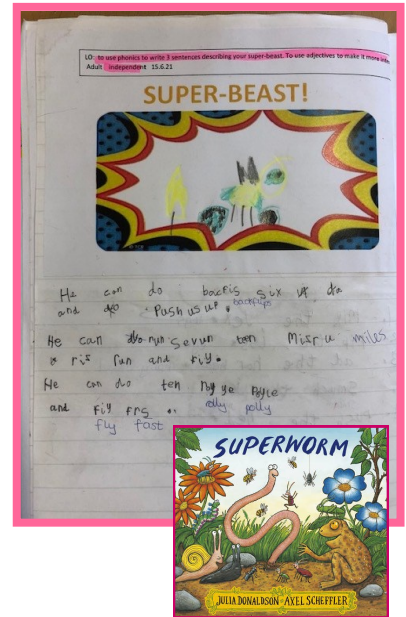
Nursery & Reception's Wonderful Work of the Week

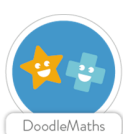

Important Reminders

Wearing Masks Please

We continue to ask that all parents/carers wear a face covering when dropping-off and collecting their child from school—we need to continue to be vigilant as we are still at risk of spreading Covid. Only people that are exempt from wearing a face covering do not have to do so when dropping-off and collecting their child. Let's all help to stay safe, keep our school open and our scholars learning.

Drop-Off and Collection

During drop-off:

We want to remind all parents/carers that parent/carers should stay and wait in the queue at a 2 meter distance from others until the gate opens and the children enters the school premises. We need to be incredibly vigilant when it comes to the safety of our children, and do so at all times. We want to ask parents to please stay with their child and not get involved in discussion with other parents/friends until their child has entered the premises.

During collection:

If parents/carers are by the collection point/gate we ask that they join the queue to have their child's name called. Please refrain from asking other parents to call for your child if you are there and waiting on the side. We really try to be as fair as possible and this doesn't seem fair to those parents waiting in the queue for their child's name to be called.

Late Collection

Please remember to collect your child on time from school. We are having a lot of children collected late from school and this is unacceptable. Reminder: Our finish times are— 3:15-3:30pm, Monday—Thursday and we close at 2:30-2:45pm every Friday. You will be charged for persistent lateness.
