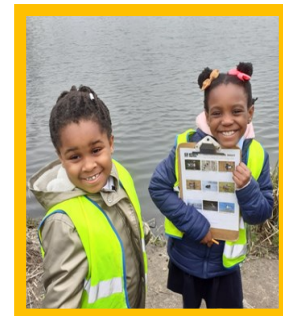


Year 2 @ the WET-
