Why should all students learn your subject?

Our MFL mission at Ark John Keats Academy is to ensure that pupils can manipulate the language accurately and confidently. Pupils are curious and feel passionately about the importance and relevance of languages and want to pursue them further.

We believe that language learning goes much deeper than the language itself. All year groups are not only exposed to the target language but also to the culture, history, literature and politics that surround the language itself. We provide a deep understanding of another language to improve pupils' native tongue, communication, empathy and understanding skills.

What is the core knowledge in your subject?

The core knowledge taught falls into three main categories:

- Vocabulary
- Grammar and linguistic structures
- Cultural practices and trends in Francophone countries

The themes studied across all key stages fall into the following categories:

- Identity and culture
- Local area, tourism and travel
- Education
- Future aspirations and the world of work
- International and global events and
- French society and politics
- Francophone literature and media

What is the key way students practise in your subject?

Students apply their knowledge of language and culture across the four skills:

- Speaking – asking and answering questions, responding to stimuli, expressing personal views and experiences.
- Listening – identifying key information from a range of audio types such as conversations, radio programmes, interviews, monologues.
- Reading – identifying key information from a range of written texts including e-mails, letters, blog posts, news articles, advertisements and translating from French to English.
- Writing – recounting experiences, expressing and justifying opinions, describing cultural practices and translating from English to French.
