All pupils should:

Continue to use doodle English and doodle maths every day to maintain key maths and literacy skills.



For Reading or phonics:

It is essential that your child practises their reading at home for at least twenty minutes a day to ensure that they develop their fluency and enjoyment of reading. This could be reading for pleasure, or reading to an adult.

Y2-Y6 Pupils- Should be reading the reading for pleasure books they have received from school.

Y1 Pupils- Should practise their reading using the phonics books on [Oxford Owl](#). The guide on how to access this resource can be found on the school website.

For mathematics, English and the wider curriculum:

Y1- Y6 pupils will use lessons on Oak Academy, BBC Bitesize or English Mastery. Your class teacher will send a links to the correct lessons via Class Dojo. These lessons will have been selected because they closely match the lessons your child will have studied in class. You can access these lessons on your phone or any other internet enabled device. Please take a picture of your child's work and upload it onto Class Dojo for their teacher to give your child feedback on their work.
