Over the course of the week the fabulous Year 1's have participated in the Phonic Screening Check.

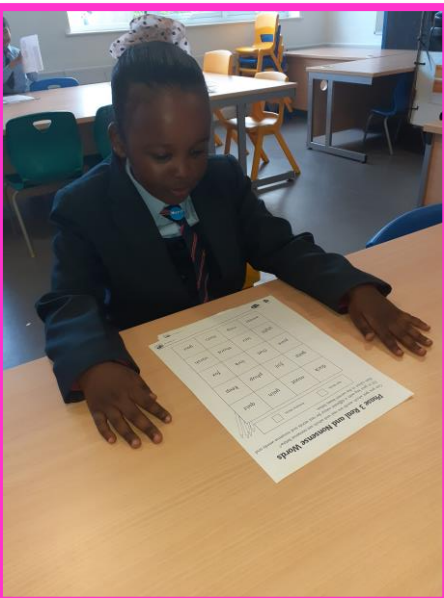
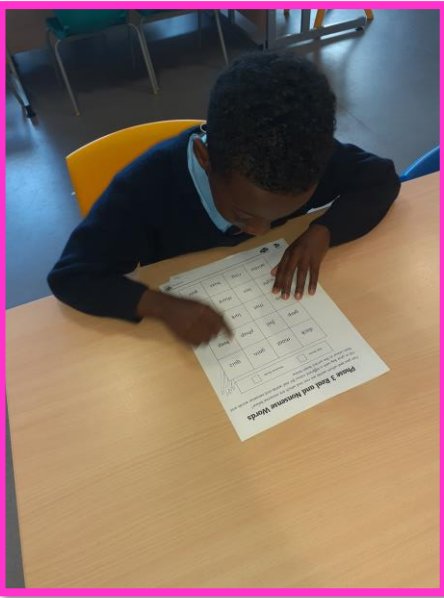
While the children are waiting they practice reading a mixture of real and nonsense words.

During the Phonics Screening Check, the children read (decode) 40 words to Ms Marshall. Most of these words are real words but some are nonsense (alien) words. Nonsense words are included to ensure that children are using their decoding skills and not just relying on their memory of words they've read before.

The words are presented in a book for the children with a variety of funny alien pictures next to the nonsense words. Miss Marshall has a check list that she marks as the child reads, Fred the Frog is also there to remind the children to Fred Talk (sound out) each word. A huge thank-you goes to Ms Marshall for administering the phonics check so well and to Y1 for working so hard!
