This week, our Year 4 scholars completed their Multiplication Tables Check. The children completed 25 times tables questions and we couldn't be prouder of them. The children were under tough time pressure, but they remained so resilient throughout. All the hard work that they have been putting in on TT Rockstars has paid off and they all came out saying, 'Was that it!?'

### What is the check?

The [multiplication tables check](#) is an **online test** for pupils in Year 4. Pupils are asked to answer **25 questions** on times tables from **two to 12**. They are given **six seconds per question**, with three seconds rest between each question, so the test should last less than five minutes. The check is about finding out which children are struggling with their times tables so that they can get extra support. It is not a judgement on what your child can do, but a way for the school to know how their teaching is going and to adjust their focus if needed.
