Head's Introduction

Once again, I would like to start by thanking our parents and carers for taking time to provide feedback to Ofsted about your experience of the school. I would also like to thank the parents that sent their well wishes to the staff, this was very much appreciated. Ofsted's aim is to publish the report 30 working days after the end of the inspection, so we would expect to share the report with all parents and carers during the week ending 10th March.

Thank you also to parents and carers that completed the information request regarding whether you are employed as a key worker. It is important that we keep our records up to date as this helps us to plan provision for these scholars in the event of school closure, for example next month one of the teaching unions will begin their strike action.

This week scholars from Year 1 and Year 5 have enjoyed the enrichment provision through learning outside the classroom. Year 1 visited Paradise Wildlife Park on Monday where their science topic, Amazing Animals, was literally brought to life by visiting the animals they have been learning about. The following day Year 5 visited the British Museum as part of their history topic about Islam. On Wednesday morning, Year 1 visited Edmonton Islamic Centre as part of their RE learning about Islam. Thank you to all parents and carers that volunteered their time to accompany the children, without you we would not be able to lead such an extensive enrichment programme for our scholars.

Attendance and Punctuality

At Ark John Keats, in order for our children to reach their full potential, it is important that they attend school every day and are on time. We have very clear expectations and know punctuality is important to establish positive habits as scholars, develop, grow and move on to their next stage.

If your child is absent due to sickness, please ring the school every day of their absence to keep us informed. If your child has an appointment at the hospital, G.P. or dentist, please bring in the letter to show proof of absence. If the appointment is in the morning, they should return to school after the appointment, and if the appointment is in the afternoon they should come to school in the morning and then go to their appointment. We must give our children the best possible chances to engage with education and be the best they can be.

Late arrival in the morning can be detrimental to your child's education and result in disruption to their peers. It can lead to missed explanations. Persistent lateness can lead to referrals to our school's education welfare officer, and we would like to avoid this happening and ask that all pupils arrive between 8.40am and 8:50am.
