Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank-you to everyone for your considered response to our RSHE consultation. It has been reassuring to know that the information made available to you over the two-week period has been well received. Feedback suggests that parents are clear on the changes to the curriculum and our school processes, as advised by the government. Feedback regarding our choice of curriculum support materials has also been positive.

Based on the parent survey:

- 82% believe that relationships and health education is an important part of the school curriculum.
- 81% believe that Relationships and health education taught in school can make a real difference to young people's lives.
- 100% are aware of the relationships and health education topics that will be covered by Jigsaw at Ark John Keats Academy.
- 86% After reading the policy, understand and agree with the content of the relationships, health and sex education policy for Ark John Keats Primary.

More specific feedback.

Ms Stanley spoke to several families about their concerns and following discussions on the phone those families were reassured that the materials the school selected were age appropriate in delivery and content. The following statements were left on the survey. Please see our response below:
