

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to say that we will be holding a Sports Day event at AJK this year, with parents and family members in attendance. This will take place on the Astroturf. Pupils will remain in school after their Sports Day and will be collected at the normal time.

When is Sports Day?

Due to the high number of pupils at AJK, we have had to split the event across 3 days:

What should children bring?

Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on the day of their Sports Day. Please make sure they bring a water bottle, sun hat and sun cream.

Where should parents and family members enter?

We would love to see as many parents and family members as possible at Sports Day. Parents and family members will enter the Astroturf through the gate that leads onto Albany Park.

Parents and family members will stay around the outside edge of the Astroturf, which will be marked with a barrier. We regret to say that, for safeguarding reasons, we cannot let parents and family members mix freely with pupils.



Parents and family members must remain on the Astroturf: you will not be able to go onto the rest of the school site. Please feel free to bring seating, as it will not be provided. Please also bring any refreshments, as well as sun hats and sun cream.

What activities will there be?

The children will follow a carousel of events that they have been learning in class. They will be given a team on the day. Parents will be able to follow their child(ren) around the activities and cheer them on.

Will there be toilets available?

Please note that if a parent or family member requires the toilet during Sports Day, you will have to leave the Astroturf through the Albany Park gate and walk round to the Primary Office. Unfortunately, parents and family members will not be able to walk through the school site.
